

# Comfort

3 Week Evening Series starts 1 June at 6:30pm

Close relationships hold enormous potential to build us up. They also have great power to undermine and tear down. Closest of all are family relationships – our parents, brothers and sisters, marriage partners and our own children. When these relationships go wrong we can find ourselves battling a host of feelings, including despair, anger and doubt.



“Comfort” is a series of 3 Sunday evening messages for those who experienced, or who have experienced, troubled relationships. Probably that’s most of us! It is for those who feel their confidence has been sapped and their courage is not what it could be (don’t worry, participants will not be “put on the spot” or made to share their own experiences). It is also suitable for those wanting to learn more about offering support in such situations.

This series looks at the greatness of God’s love towards us and the reality of His kindness through Jesus. It combines Biblical teaching with practical advice. It considers what it means to “love our enemies” and how to cope with past and on-going damaging relationships. Seeing things from the perspective of eternity can revolutionise our way of coping.
